#### PREPERATION FOR USE

Shake well before use.

Unscrew the caps of Item 464-040, the Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint and Item 463-000, Anti-Spill Carfusion Dye Holder.

Pour the Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint into the Anti-Spill Holder up to 1" to 1.5" from bottom. Screw the caps back on both the Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint and Anti-Spill Carfusion Dye Holder.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint is a long lasting skin marking dye. It dissolves skin oils and penetrates into the pores and will resist mild washings. It is recommended to do a small skin test for 24 hours before using over a large area.

Always wear gloves when using the Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint.

#### **PROCEDURE – To Mark Patient**

Insert one Pointed Wood Stick Applicator, Item 464-080, into the hole on the top of the Anti-Spill Carfusion Dye Holder, Item 463-000.

Remove the Applicator Stick from the Anti-Spill Carfusion Dye Holder and mark patient with applicator (like using a pencil/pen).

When the Applicator Stick is no longer leaving paint on patient – put the applicator stick in a trash receptacle.

If more marking on patient is required repeat the above steps.

**NEVER RE-INSERT** Applicator Stick into the Anti-Spill Carfusion Dye Holder after use on a patient.

#### **WARNING**

On rare occasion, a patient's skin could react to this chemical, forming small water blister where the dye was applied.

#### **DANGER POISON:**

Contains ethanol denatured with methanol.

May be FATAL if ingested

### **REMOVAL**

Easy removal of Carfusion Dye/Castellanis Paint is accomplished by using Erado-Sol Stain Remover (Item 466-00 or 466-100).
